<p>Maths Skill: Count reliably up to 20 Activity: Object hunt! Can you find 20 objects around your home? Next, can you group your items into sets of 2s, 5s, and 10s. Date completed</p>	<p>Literacy Skill: Pre-cursive letter formation families Activity: Please visit and download Ladder Letters. https://www.twinkl.co.uk/resource/t-l-8914-letter-formation-families-display-posters There are also examples of these on our main Home Learning Page. <i>In addition, please visit youtube and search for: pre-cursive letter formation. <p>Maths Skill: Use non-standard units of measurement to measure height Activity: How many people do you have in your family? Are they all the same height? Can you use objects (e.g. blocks, sticks, boxes) to measure how tall each of your family are... E.g. Mum is 5 boxes tall while dad is 6 boxes tall. Work out who is shortest to tallest in your family. Draw a picture to show your measurements. Date completed</p>	<p>Literacy Skill: Phonics Activity: Please visit and select from a range of activities found at: http://www.letters-and-sounds.com/ What things can you write labels for in the house? Sound out the labels carefully. Date completed</p>

Maths Skill: Mentally recall 'one more' within 20

Activity:

Can you write your 5 favourite numbers between 1 and 20. E.g. 3, 15, 2, 19, 10. What is one more than 3, what is one more than 15...

Literacy Skill: Select letters to compose writing

Activity:

Write the alphabet in small letters. Can you circle all the letters in your first name? Can you write a sentence that includes your own name? E.g. Daisy went to the park.

Maths Skill: Mentally recall 'one less' within 20

Activity:

Can you write your 5 favourite numbers between 1 and 20. E.g. 3, 15, 2, 19, 10. What is one less than 3, what is one less than 15...

Literacy Skill: Retell events from a narrative in the right order

Activity:

What was the last story that you read? Can you talk about what happened in the story? Can you tell us what happened in the right order... Can you draw a picture to show the beginning of the story, the middle of the story and the end of the story.
