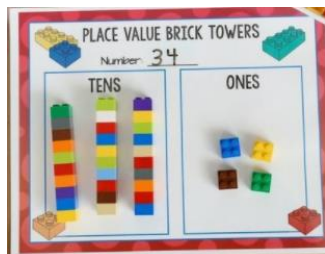
Maths Skill: to understand place value

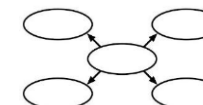
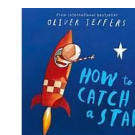
